1. A nationalist and a spirited Advocate of this Court, Mr. Malwinder Jit Singh Waraich has filed the instant petition with a prayer that the sacrifices made by the martyrs and revolutionaries of Kuka Namdhari Movement, 1871 have gone unnoticed and even their names have not been recognised in the list of movements recognized for the purpose of Swatantra Sainik Samman Pension Scheme, 1980 (for brevity '1980 Scheme'). The petitioner is a researcher of the movements and mutinies relating to the freedom of India and has published many books on the subject. However, Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Freedom Fighter Division, has issued a letter dated 13.12.2008, stating that both the Kuka Namdhari

Movement, 1871 and the Jallianwala Bagh Massacre, 1919 have been formally included in the list of freedom movements recognised for the purpose of grant of pension under 1980 Scheme.
